LOST VILLAGES HISTORICAL SOCIETY

With September now upon us, our summer historical interpreters have now returned to high school, college, and university. We wish Miranda, Tenley, Lily, Owen and Evan the very best in their studies. They did a fantastic job with making sure the museum was in tip-top shape and greeting patrons and tourists to the museum site. In my opinion, summer passed us by far too quickly. We thank the Township of South Stormont for hiring the students as part of their summer employment program for students.

The museum is now open from Tuesdays to Sundays until September 28, 2025. Please note that the September hours are from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Lost Villages Historical Society members and friends are at the museum in September to welcome you and answer your questions. We thank member Sheila Merpaw for taking on the scheduling of volunteers. All buildings are open, with volunteers stationed at the Manson/Lapierre Store (museum's gift shop) and at the Stuart House. Jim Brownell, president and archivist of the historical society, will be at the archives in the Forbes Memorial Reading Room on most week days (Tuesday to Friday) in September. If you have the need

to research there, I would suggest that you make an appointment through the historical society's website. As well, you are welcome to email at jim.k.brownell@gmail.com.

Over the winter months, work will commence on displays for the basement at the Stuart House. With the basement completely restored, and alarmed sump pumps in place, we hope that we have resolved the problems that were experienced in January of this year.

We are saddened to report that vandals struck at the museum site in Ault Park overnight on September 4th-5th. The two brass plaques on the Ault Park Memorial Stone were removed, after 66 years at the location at the Lost Villages Museum. The original plaque was unveiled in 1914 at the original Ault Park on Sheek Island, with the smaller plaque unveiled in 1959 when the park was re-dedicated on the mainland. The plaques memorialized Simon William and Caroline (Brownell) Ault, born at Moulinette and Mille Roches respectively. Also removed from the park was the memorial stone and plaque dedicated to the memory of Mary (Denny) Gallinger from Mille Roches. The plaque and beautiful flowering crab apple tree were provided at the park by the descendants of Mary. It's a shame that such disrespect would be shown at our museum site.

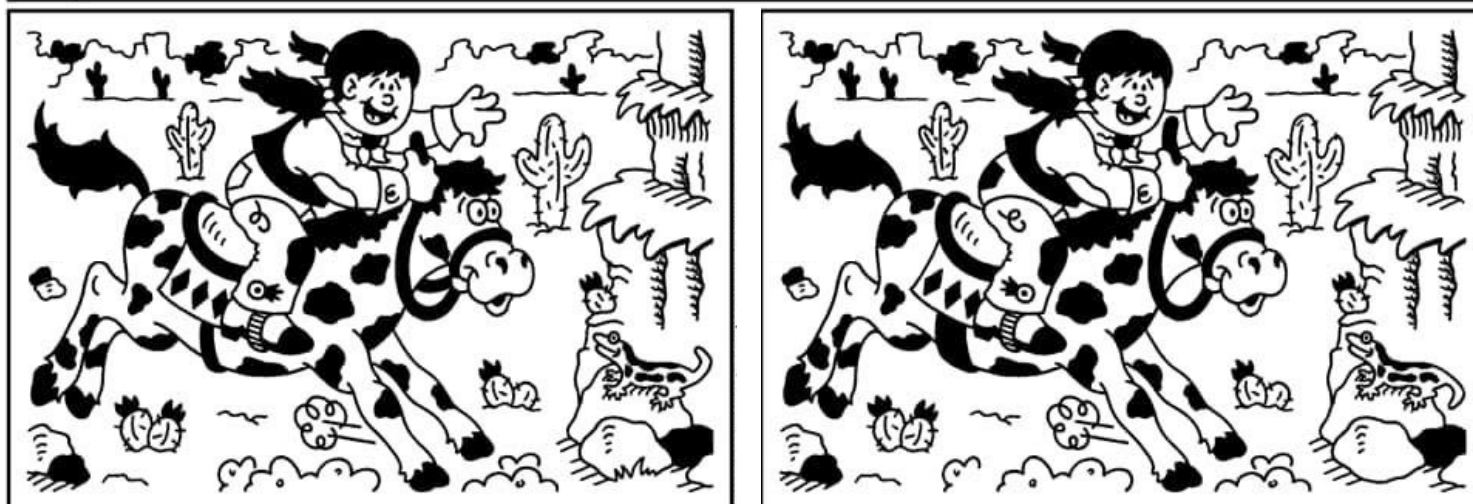

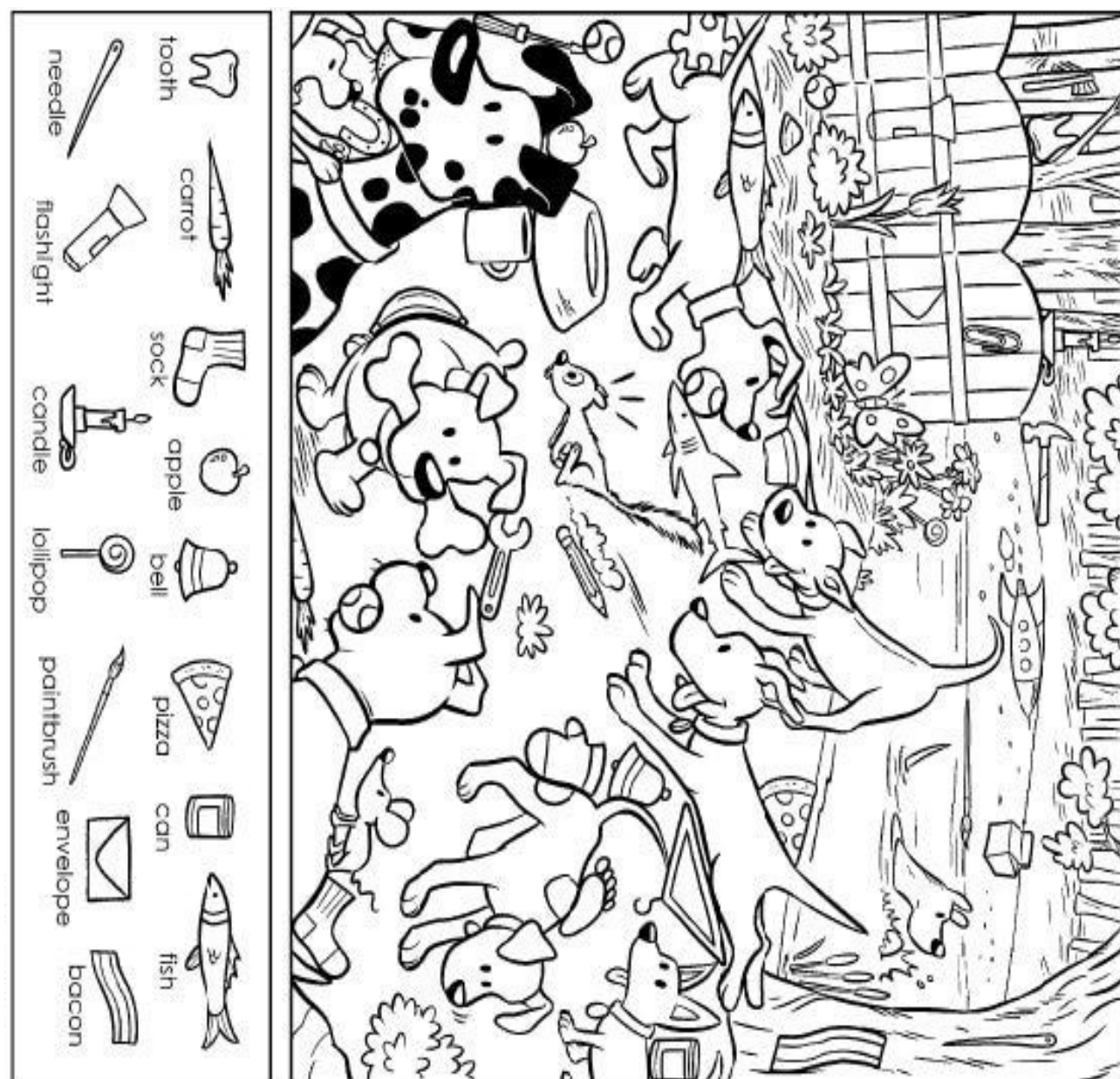
