## LOST VILLAGES HISTORICAL SOCIETY

In reflecting back on the activities at the Lost Villages Museum in August, one can easily say that it's been a busy time at the South Stormont's premier tourist site. Folks have been flocking to the site to learn about the Hydro and Seaway projects of the 1950s and to see the efforts by the historical society to preserve those memories. We are pleasantly surprised at the number of international visitors to the site, and I had the opportunity to welcome visitors from Holland, Iran, and England this past week. In a conversation with a guest from England, I learned that she had been a student in England in the 1950s and had learned about both projects and the relocation of people. She remarked about the "big deal" it was to learn about the story.

With the Forbes Memorial Reading Room (Archives) now open, the historical society has seen an increase in visits from researchers wishing to learn more about our story and their families that were affected by the relocation. This past week we welcomed researchers from Nanaimo, British Columbia, and Waterloo, Ontario. The folks from Nanaimo were researching families and businesses in Aultsville, with the Waterloo researchers discovering the

burial sites of their ancestors, the descendants of Rev. Samuel Schwerdfeger, a German immigrant to North America and the first Evangelical Lutheran Minister in Upper Canada. I showed them the Schwerdfeger memorial in St. John's Lutheran Church Cemetery at Riverside Heights.

The bus tour "Through the Lands of the Lost Villages" on Sunday, August 24th, was a huge success with a sold out audience. The historical society apologizes to all those who missed out on getting seats on the last few bus tours of 2025. Although encouraged by many folks to add an extra tour, as there is a waiting list of 25+ people, I have made the decision to retire as the host of the tours on September 14th. I still plan to do "Step-On" bus tours for organizations and tour companies wishing to visit the area. Cardinal Lakeshore Tours from Bowmanville, Ontario, will host one of these tours on October 17, 2025.

The Grays and Blues of Montreal, a Civil War Re-enactment Society, will host a Re-enactment and Drill Day at the museum site on Sunday, September 14th. We hope you will stop by for a visit.

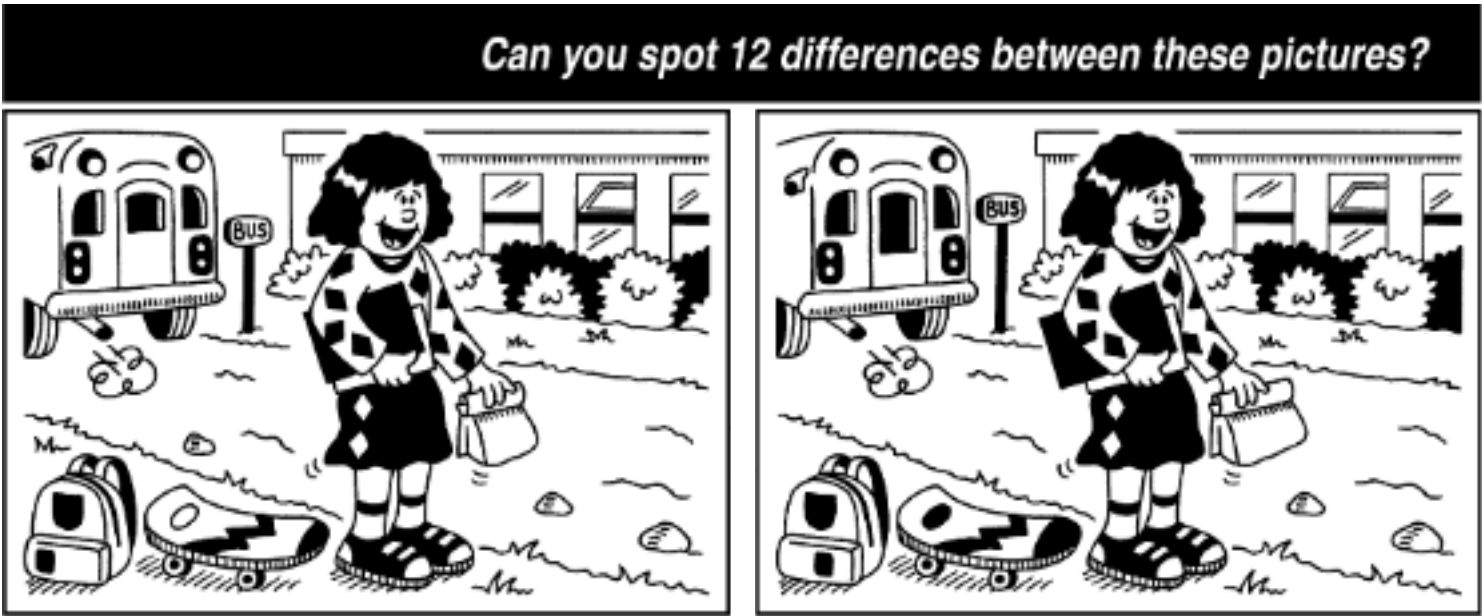

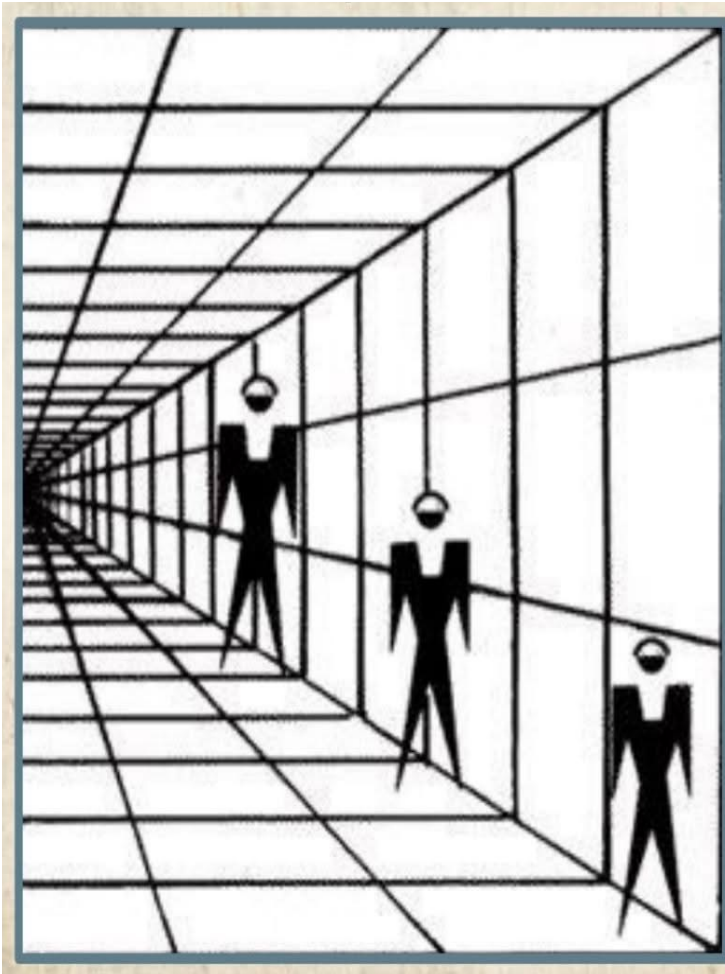
