The Duke of Edinburgh" on one side, and the words "Commemorating The Royal Visit To Open The Seaway 1959" on the other.

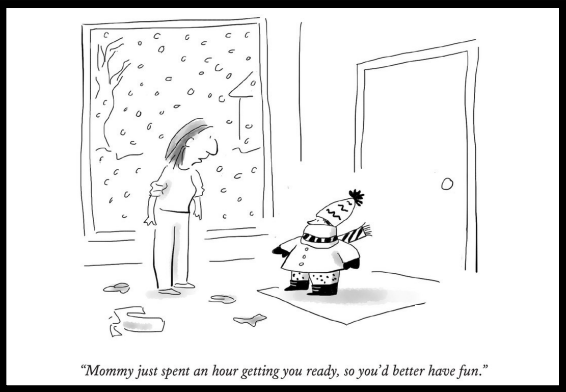

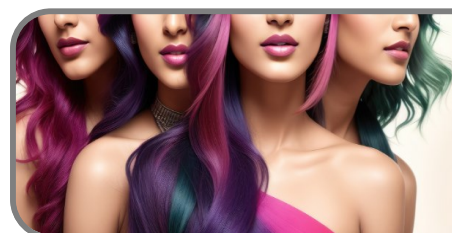
