So my wife called him a "jerk". He finished the second ticket and put it on the windshield with the first. Then he started writing more tickets.



LOST VILLAGES HISTORICAL SOCIETY

As many know, the Lost Villages Museum sits in South Stormont's oldest park, with the original Ault Park site on Sheek's Island extending back to 1914, when Levi Addison Ault gave the park to the Township of Cornwall in memory of his parents, Simon William and Caroline (Brownell) Ault. Today, the municipality tends to the upkeep of the replacement park along with the work to keep the museum buildings in tip top shape. Municipal work is done through the Parks and Recreation Department of the township.

Recently, Meaghan Meerburg was appointed as the new Manager of Community Programs and Partnerships. We welcome Meaghan to the municipality, and we look forward to our partnerships with her. Earlier this summer, the municipality welcomed Jason Lavallee as the new Manager of Parks and Facilities. The Lost Villages Historical Society has had many opportunities to work with Jason, and we look forward to continued positive partnership with Jason and all others in the department. As always, we appreciate the work of Kevin Amelotte, Director of Recreation and Facilities Services. The municipality will continue to showcase the

museum and archives to tourists and patrons to the museum site at Ault Park.

This is another reminder of the October meeting of the historical society. We hope to see a large turnout of members and friends at the meeting. Remember, you do not need to be a member to attend. Why not pop around and see what we do. For \$15.00 annually, you just may decide to become a member. The meeting will be held on Monday, October 20, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. in the John Cleary Room at the Long Sault Arena. The guest speaker will be Gerry Duguid, a participant in the Centennial Voyageur Canoe Pageant held to

commemorate Canada's Centennial Year in 1967. The canoe race started on May 24, 1967, in the Rocky Mountains of Canada and ended on September 4, 1967, in Montreal. No doubt, Mr. Duguid will have many interesting tales to tell about his experiences with this canoe event.

Two very successful paranormal investigations were held at the museum site on September 19th and 20th through Phantoms of Yore. Once again, there was great community support and substantial funds were raised for the historical society. We extend sincere appreciation to Gloria and Rick Waldroff and their helpers for their partnership with the staging this very successful activity.


