LOST VILLAGES HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The Lost Villages Museum is now closed after its 28th season of interpreting the history of the St. Lawrence Seaway and Hydro Development projects. Over the years, the museum has developed into a significant heritage and cultural space in the Township of South Stormont.

The numbers are in, and we are happy to report that we had the best year ever since beginning to track visitors to the museum site in 2010. Using the signatures in the museum's guest book and a formula for tourist sites that do not have a singular entrance point, we have an estimated total of 19,863 visitors. For comparison, we had 7,672 in 2010, the first year for tracking visitors. With some of these visitors stopping at our community's restaurants, stores, and gas stations, imagine the economic spin-offs from these visits.

The majority of visitors recorded in our guest register were from the Kingston-Ottawa-Lancaster triangle, although we had visitors from every province and territory except Prince Edward Island. Visitors from 28 U.S. states and the District of Columbia signed in to the museum's registry.

In 2025, we saw an increase in the number of international travellers at the museum site. They were from France, United Kingdom, Germany, Austria,

Netherlands, Belgium, Bavaria, Hungary, Poland, Switzerland, Finland, Sweden, Denmark, Ukraine, Russia, Czech Republic, Luxembourg, Israel, Iran, Malaysia, Costa Rica, Mexico, China, Japan, Argentina, India, South Africa, Australia, New Zealand, and Armenia.

Since 2010, executive member Tim Gault has been keeping and reporting on the visitor statistics for the museum. We thank him for this work.

The next monthly meeting of the historical society will be held on Monday, November 17, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. in the John Cleary Room at the Long Sault Arena. The presentation, led by historical society member Art Buckland, will take the form of an interactive presentation, with audience participation. The two-part presentation will feature: Some hitherto unknown aspects of life on Sheek Island, and Mystery at S.S.#6, Sheek Island Public School.

As many know, executive member John Sliter has released his first book, "The Matriarchs of the Hoople Creek Loyalists". Proceeds from the sale of the books will be used for gravestone restorations at Pleasant Valley Cemetery, South Stormont. John will be at Coles Book Store, Cornwall Square, on Saturday, November 1st from 12:00 noon to 3:00 p.m. for a "Meet the Author and Book Signing". We hope to see you there!

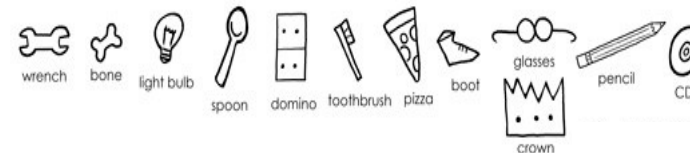
